New MLDS Forms (DRE)

If you are licensed by the California Department of Real Estate (DRE) and are originating Mortgage Loans, make sure that you are using the most current versions of the Mortgage Loan Disclosure Statements (MLDS). There were revised forms introduced by the DRE in January, 2008, and most of the software vendors have yet to update the software with the new forms (as of April, 2008). The forms are numbered RE-882, RE-883, RE-885 and are available for printing from the DRE website (www.dre.ca.gov).

Increased Audits (DRE and DOC)

Licensees are receiving letters or being called daily by both the DRE and the DOC (CFL and CRMLA) to schedule regulatory audits. Even those who have discontinued originating Mortgage Loans are not exempt from these audits for up to three (3) years after the last transaction closed. Are you prepared?

Best Practices and Policies (DOC CFL and CRMLA)
